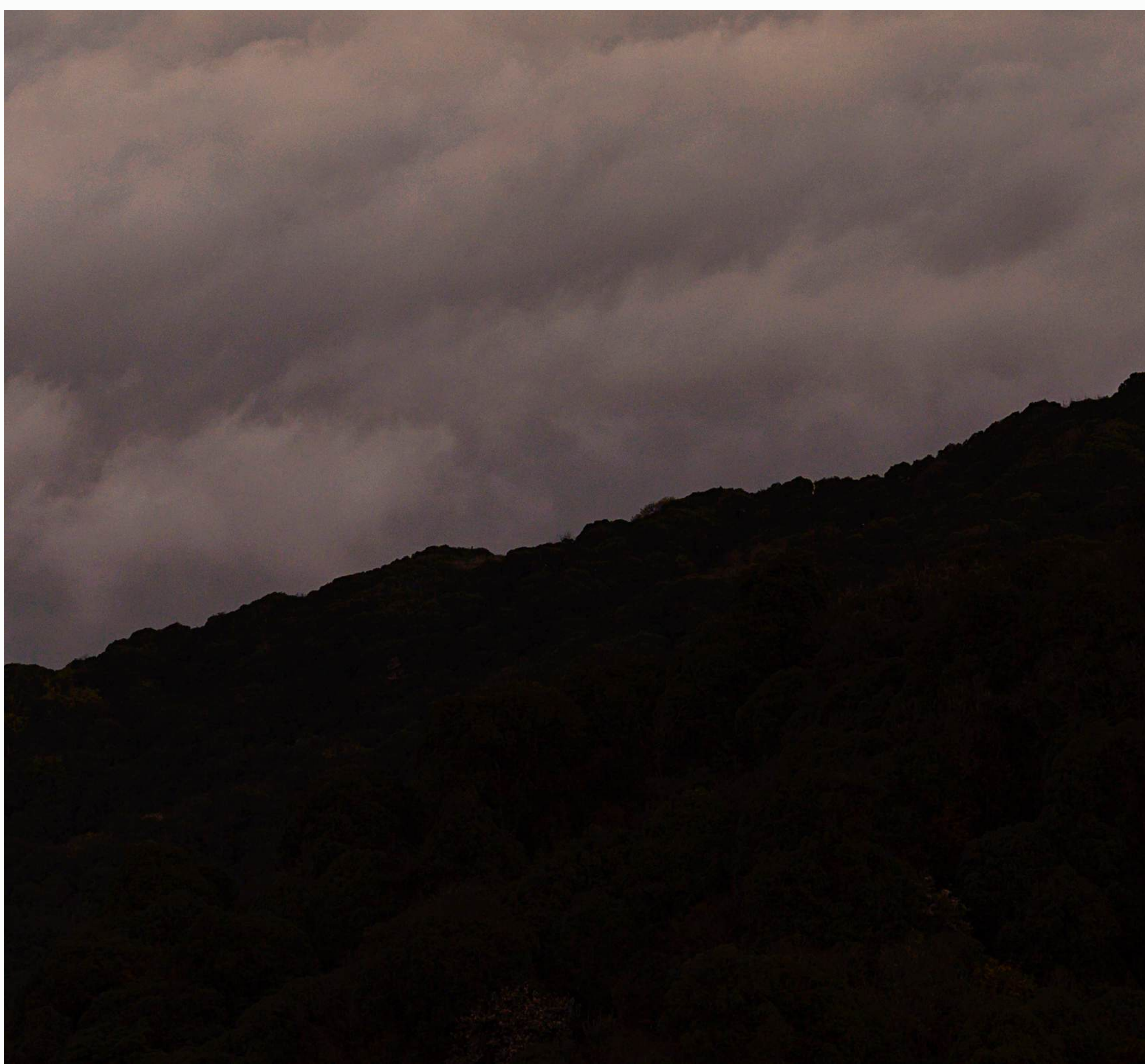
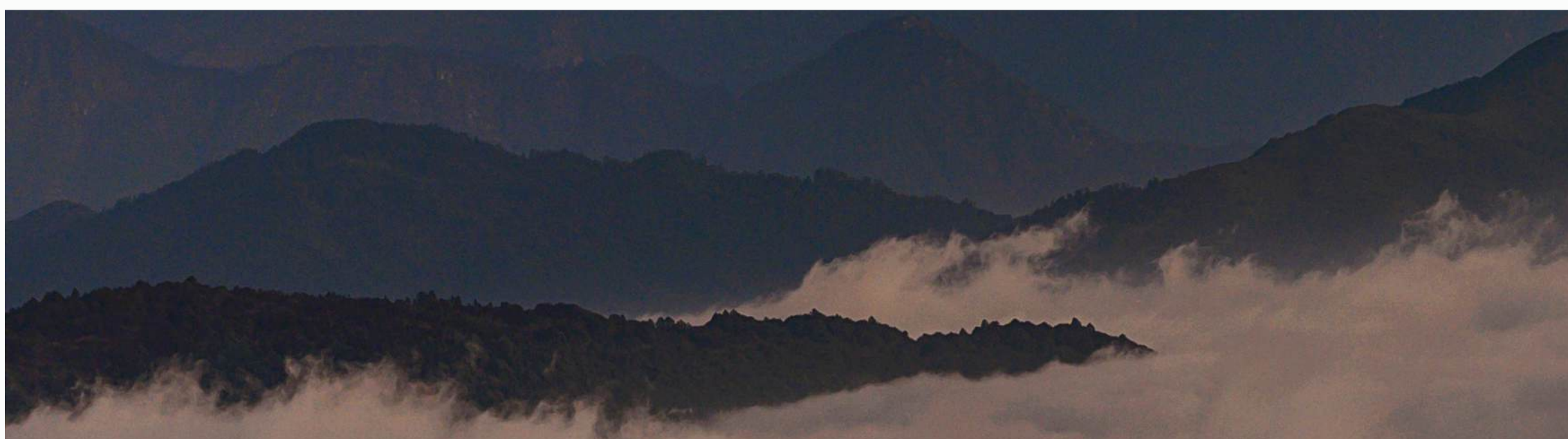
RED PANDAS OF SINGALILA

The Red Panda, also known as the 'firefox,' is a charming and rare mammal native to the Eastern Himalayas. With reddish-brown fur, a long bushy tail, and an adorable appearance, this 2-foot-long, 10 kg animal is a photogenic favorite. Primarily arboreal, it feeds on bamboo, eggs, birds, and insects, and is most active from dusk to dawn. Classified as endangered due to habitat loss and poaching, less than 10,000 remain in the wild. Singalila National Park is one of its last strongholds and the best place in India to spot this elusive creature.

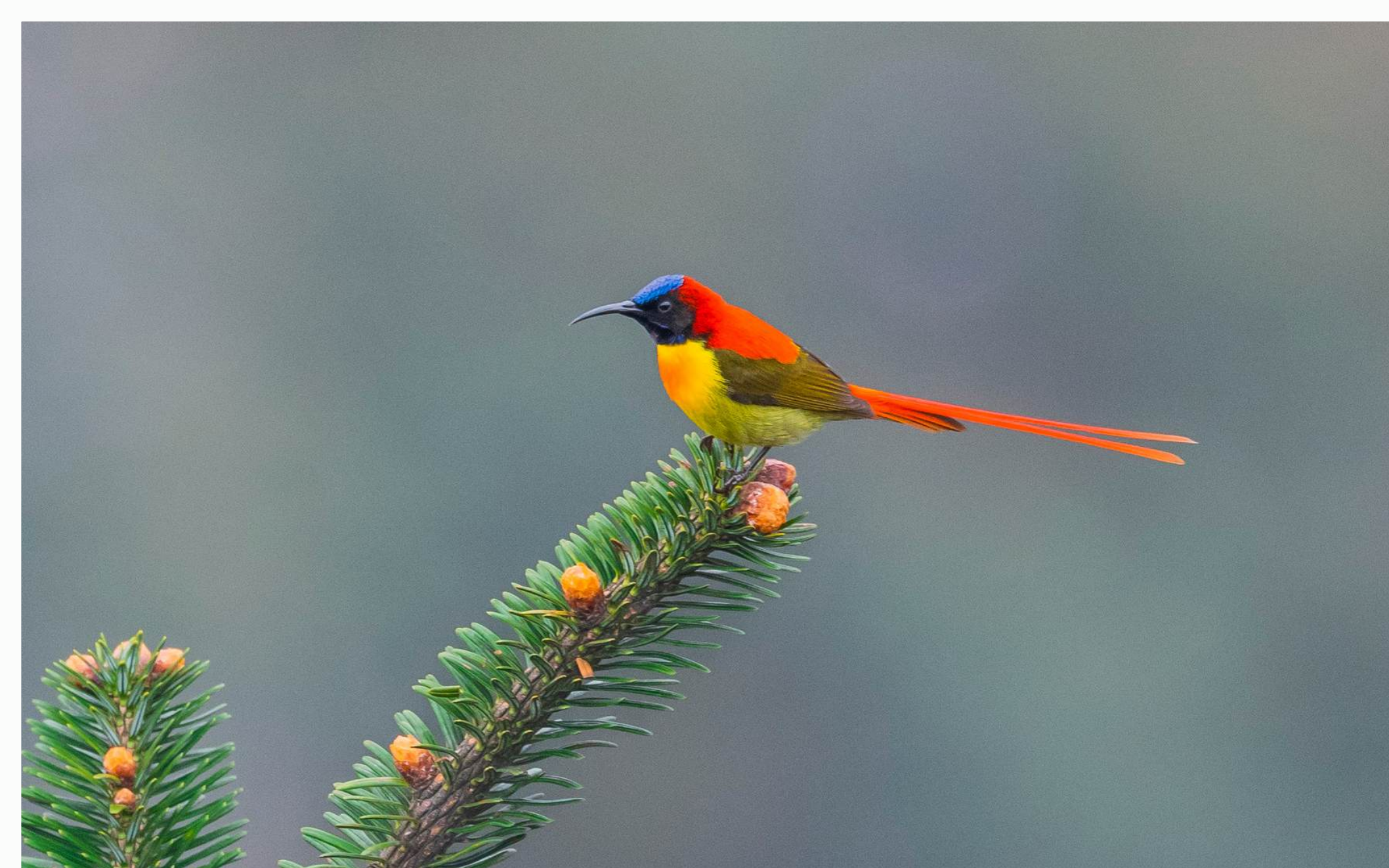


Singalila National Park, located in the Darjeeling district at the West Bengal, Sikkim, and Nepal tri-junction, is a mystical Himalayan forest known for the Sandakphu trek and vintage Land Rovers. It's one of the best places to spot the elusive Red Panda and is home to diverse wildlife, including the Himalayan Black Bear and over 300 bird species. With stunning views of Mount Everest and Kanchenjunga, Singalila offers an unforgettable experience for nature lovers and adventurers.

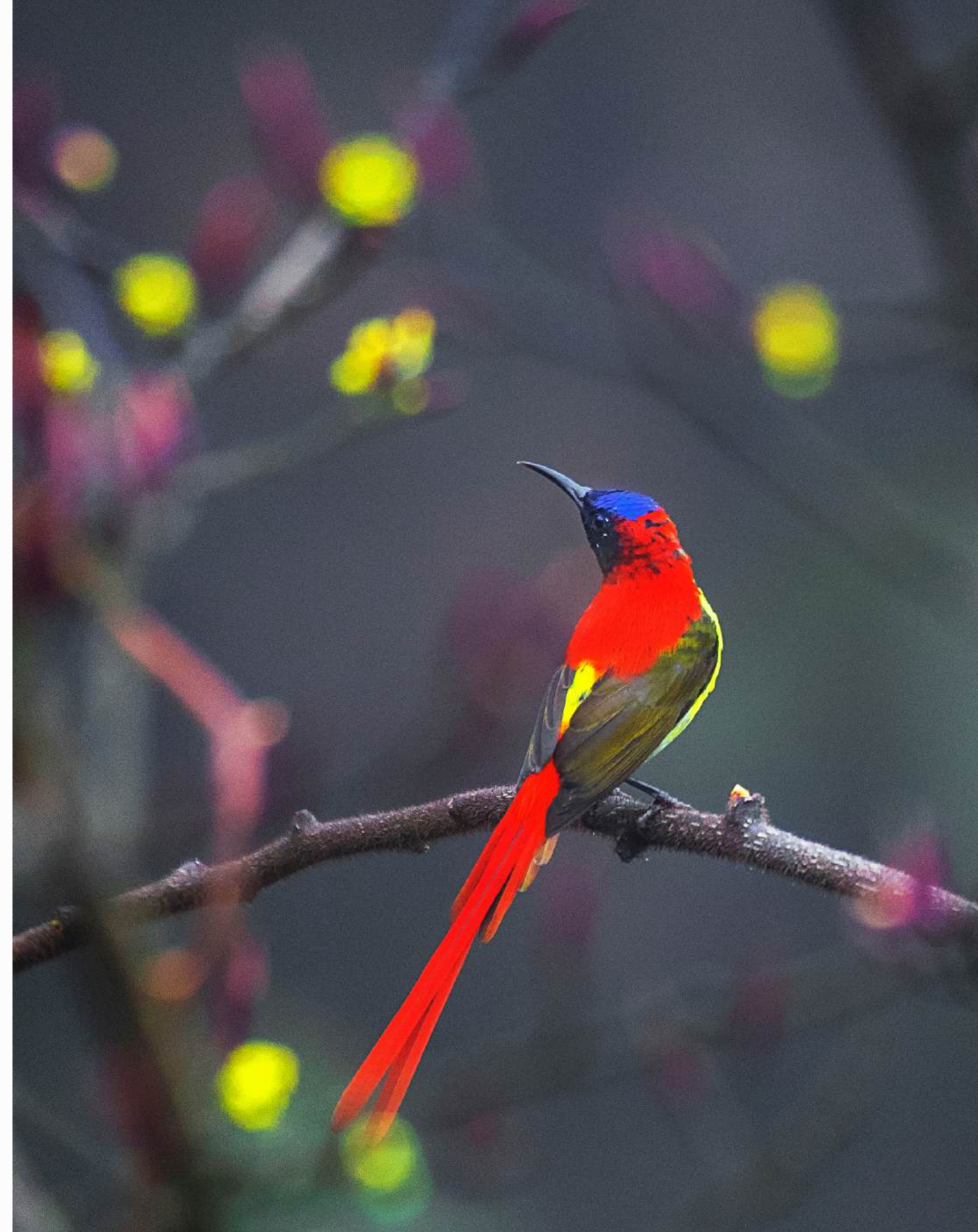
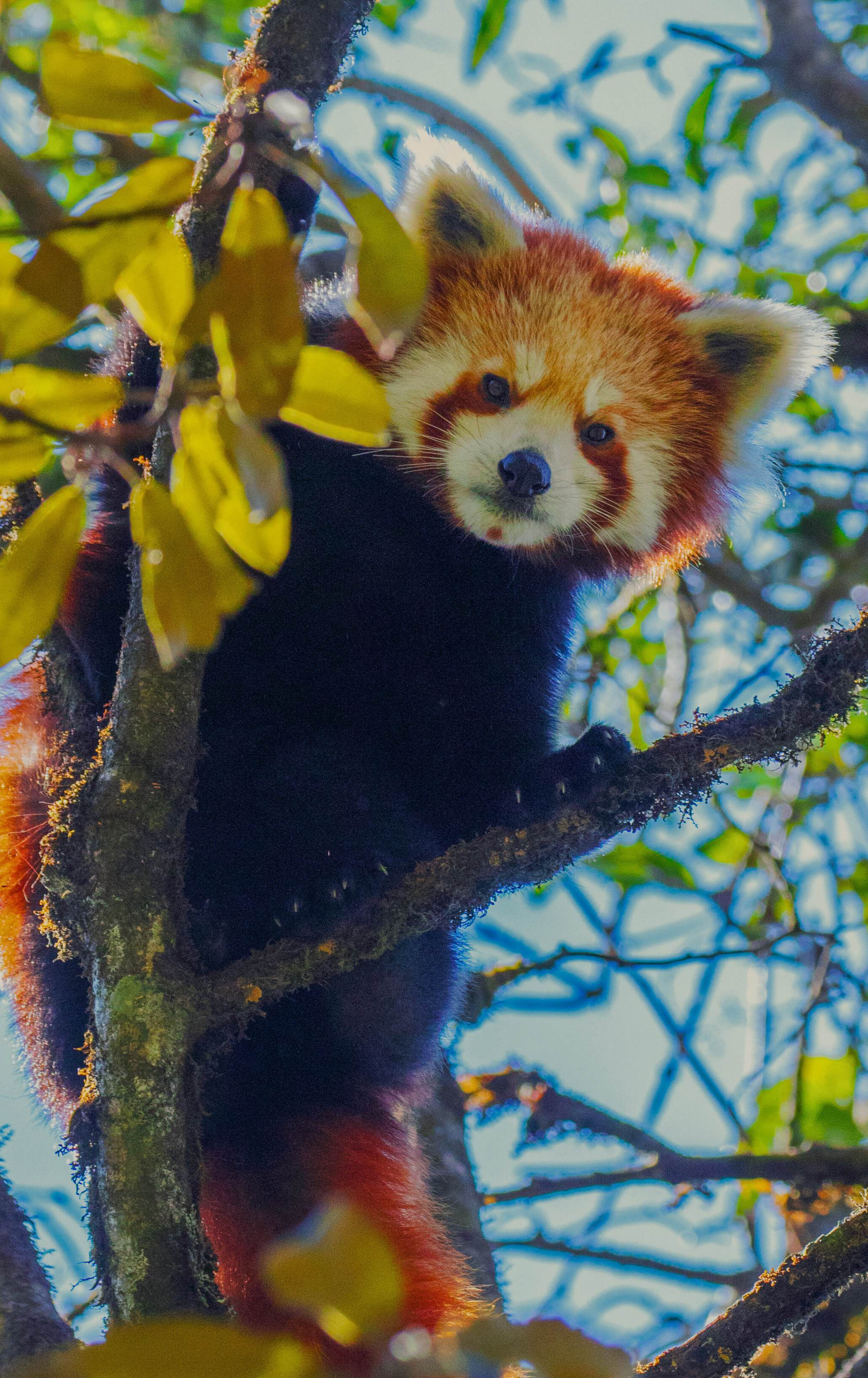
Singalila National Park is a haven for wildlife lovers, offering more than just the elusive Red Panda. The park is home to an incredible variety of mammals and birds.



Mammals, including the Himalayan Black Bear, Clouded Leopard, Leopard Cat, Serow, Barking Deer, Yellow-throated Marten, Pangolin, and Wild Boar can be spotted at Singalila.



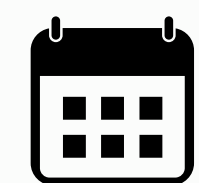

ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival

Drive from Bagdogra to Tumling/Jaubari village, Himalayan villages nearest to Singalila Forest. Stay at Shikhar Logde in Tumling or Lucky homestay in Jaubari and head out in a 4x4 to spot some wildlife. Enjoy an evening hike and dinner.

Day 2: Red Panda Tracking

After breakfast, join trackers to search for Red Pandas. Walk or take a 4x4 to sightings, with birdwatching along the way. Lunch in the field or lodge, followed by more wildlife activities.



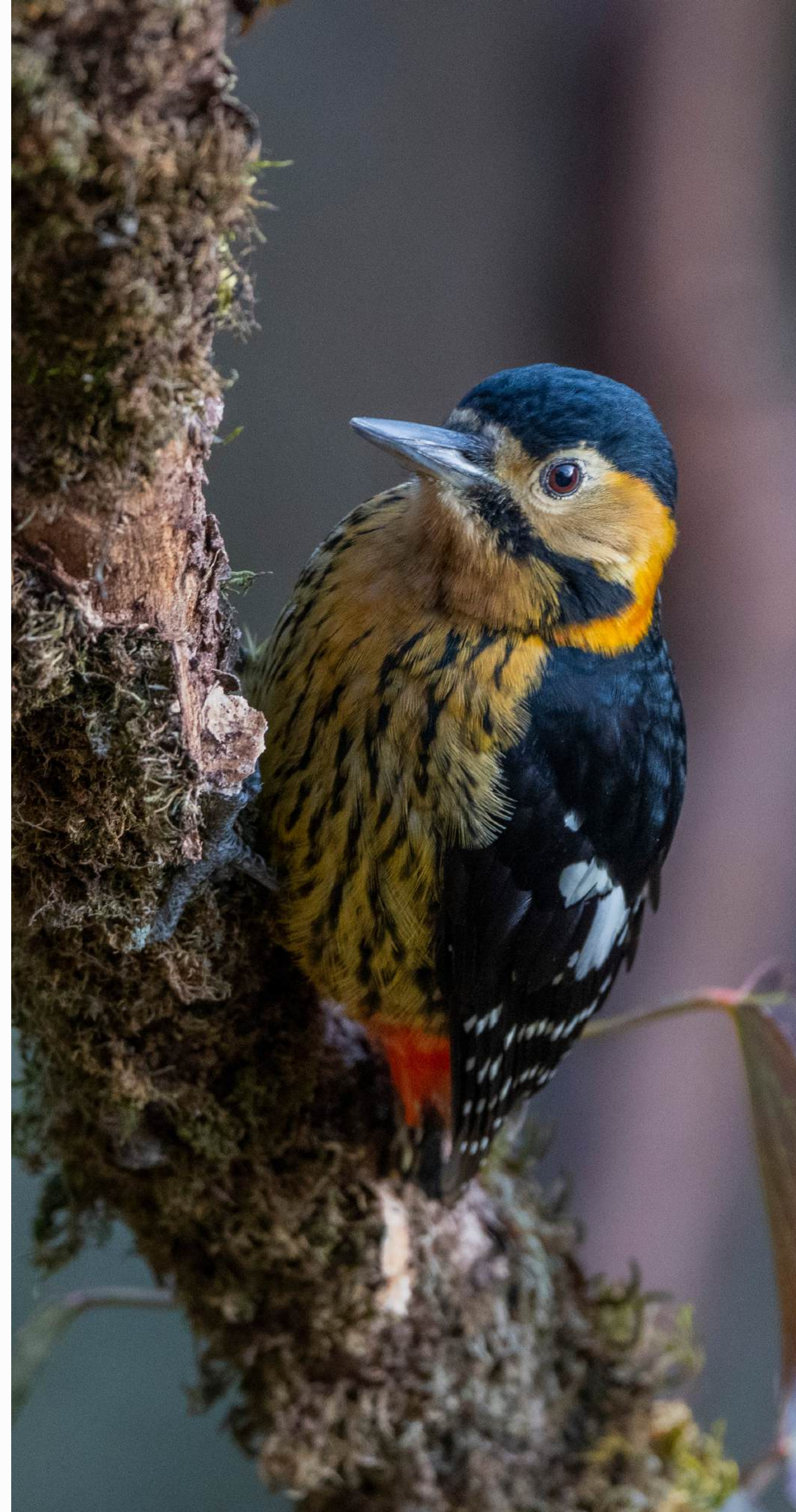
ITINERARY

Days 3-5: Wildlife Exploration

Track Red Pandas and explore Singalila's stunning views; The Kanchendzonga peak along with other surrounding peaks form the sleeping Buddha, which can be best viewed from Tumling. Visit nearby villages and enjoy scenic drives or walks.

Day 6: Departure

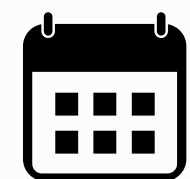
Morning safari and birding in Singalila. After breakfast, depart for Bagdogra Airport.

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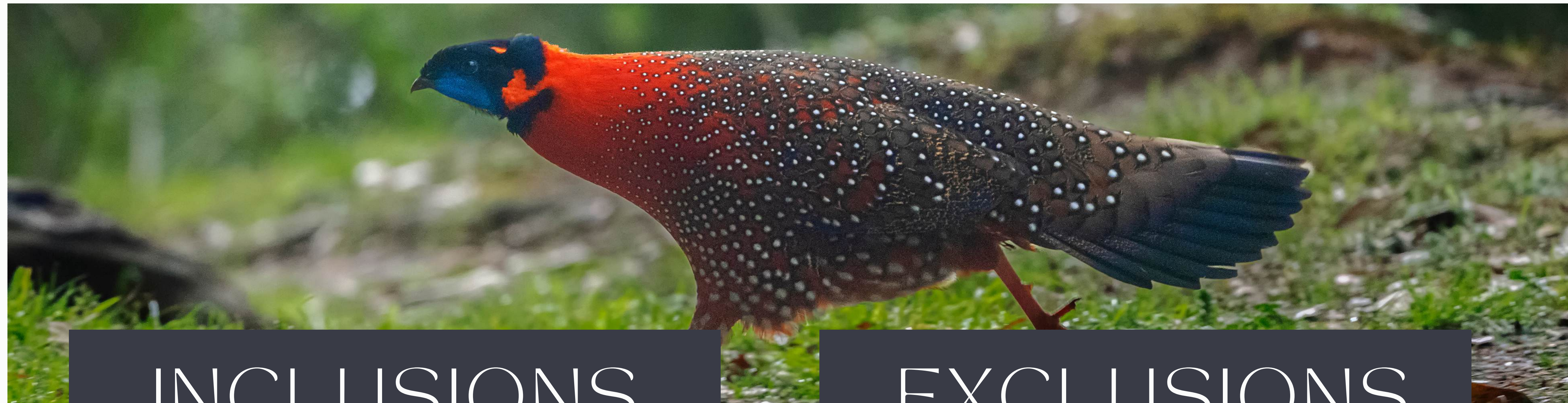

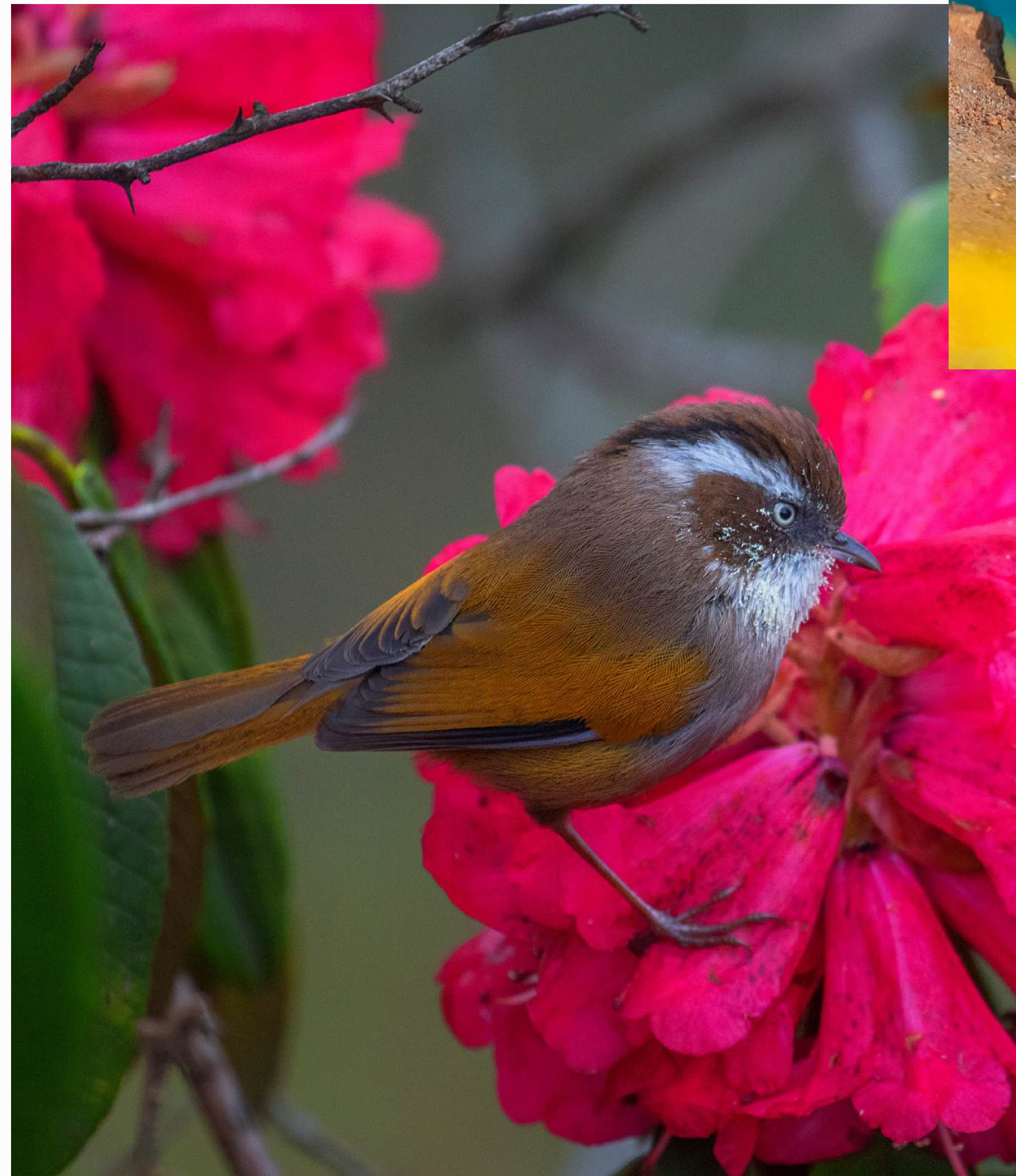

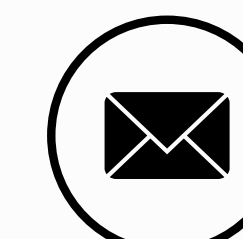
